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This Valentine's Day...Go All Out and Call A Cab



Cabernet Sauvignon is the dominant grape in the Bordeaux region of France and has spread to every other major growing region.

What is it about Cabernet? It is a wine of power and integrity, and the mere mention of it conjures visions of fireplaces and cigars, candlelight and Casablanca, sizzling steaks and large, crystal glasses of swirling, ruby-black magic.

Cabernet Sauvignon references both the grape and the wine it produces. Genetic testing has shown that it is the offspring of Cabernet Franc and Sauvignon Blanc, which in their near proximity to one another happened to cross-pollenate, giving birth to a brilliant vinous child in the 1600s. Since that time, this new grape began

being propagated through vine cuttings, spreading its charm from Bordeaux to California, South America to Australia, and many places in between.

The Medoc and Graves sub-regions of Bordeaux began producing the wine in the 1800s, oftentimes blending it with different proportions of Merlot and Cabernet Franc, creating the red Bordeaux that wine lovers have been appreciating ever since.

These same grapes are used to create Meritage wines (rhymes with

heritage), the American take on Bordeaux. The best quality California Cabs typically come from vineyards in Sonoma's Alexander Valley, the majority of Napa Valley and Paso Robles.

Though Cabernet grapes make esteemed wines of refinement, it is not the quiet seduction of, say, Pinot Noir. Rather, it is more of a strapping wine, strong and sturdy and comfortable with everything from billiards to the Opera, from an outdoor steak roast to a romantic Valentine's dinner. By the same token, its brawn and versatility make it highly adaptable to a variety of climates. Cabernet Sauvignon is a hearty grape.

Cabernet is at its best in moderately warm, somewhat dry regions with a long growing season. Typical Cab aromas and flavors are black currant, blackberry, bell pepper and mint; and oak aging imparts vanilla and toffee overtones. It is a full-bodied wine with immense complexity and richness.

Temperature extremes, overly rich soil, inadequate

sun and harvesting the grapes before full ripeness is achieved all affect the resulting wine, swapping out vegetal flavors for the rich, ripe fruit associated with Cabernet that has seen ideal growing conditions and vinification techniques.

Valentine's Day is approaching, providing the perfect opportunity to experiment with a new Cabernet or to revisit a favorite or two. Picture this: A roaring fireplace, steak Diane or rack of lamb for two (see page four), candles, two glasses and, of course, a bottle — or more — of Cabernet Sauvignon.

A few to consider trying: **Robert Mondavi** Napa '07, Myuge '07, **Sterling Vineyards** SVR Reserve Bordeaux Blend '07 (91 Pts WE), **Ramey** Claret Napa Valley '06 (91 Pts WS) or **Stag's Leap Wine Cellars** Artemis '07 (94 Pts WE).

However you celebrate Cupid's arrow, make sure to light a fire and open a Cab. ♦

Sheila: Broadside Chardonnay '08 (California) \$16.99 (reg \$19.99) This beautiful Chard has mineral notes as well as apple blossom, honey and a touch of citrus. Sublime with crab cakes or butter-bedecked lobster.

Damian: Myuge Cabernet Sauvignon '07 (Napa) \$25.49 (reg \$29.99) Ripe fruit palate of plum, blackberries and cassis with notes of tobacco and cedar. Perfect with a steak drizzled with a rich wine sauce.

Denise: Chateau Malmaison Baronne Nadine de Rothschild Bordeaux '06 (Bordeaux) \$16.99 (reg \$19.99) 90 Pts (WS) A Merlot-driven Bordeaux, this wine is deep, dark and intense with notes of blackberry and currant.

Graham: Clayhouse Adobe Red '08 (California) \$11.49 (reg \$13.99) A delicious blend of Zinfandel, Syrah, Petite Sirah, Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot, Tempranillo and Merlot, it is fruit forward, full-bodied and dry with good tannins on the finish. A good alternative to Zin for those Superbowl wings and noshes.

Chris: The Pinot Project '09 (California) \$10.99 (reg \$12.99) Pure Pinot aromas and palate of black cherries kissed by oak and a touch of Asian spice. Perfect for pan-seared salmon or even a Valentine's filet mignon.

Bob: Kunde Zinfandel '06 (Sonoma) \$10.49 (reg \$12.99) Zesty boysenberry, black pepper, anise and cloves, this is a great wine for a variety of fare and is a perfect Superbowl wine.

Sheila's Kahlua Chili

A Superbowl Spectacular!

2 Pounds Ground Beef
1 Large Onion
1 - 15oz can Black Beans
1 - 15oz can Kidney Beans
1 - 25 oz Jar Dominick's Tomato Sauce (P Chop or McCarroll's)
2 Packets Chili Seasoning Mix
½ Cup Kahlua Liqueur
(or more if desired!!!!!!)



Sauté ground beef and onions in olive oil in a large sauce pot until golden brown. Stir in drained beans, tomato sauce, chili seasoning and Kahlua. Bring to a boil, reduce heat to low and simmer for 1 hour, stirring occasionally. Open a Red Zin or your favorite Red blend, and watch the game with your wildest friends.

Rack of Lamb With Arugula for Two

A Happy Valentine

1 rack of baby lamb, trimmed and frenched
4 1/2 Tbsp extra-virgin olive oil
1 bunch arugula, rinsed and dried
2 1/2 Tbsp sherry vinegar
1/2 tsp Dijon mustard
1/2 tsp fresh rosemary
Salt and freshly ground black pepper



Preheat oven to 425 degrees. Brush the lamb with one-half Tbsp olive oil and place in a baking pan in the oven. Roast for 20 minutes (for medium rare), then remove from the oven and set aside for at least 15 minutes longer. Remove any heavy stems from the arugula and place in a bowl. Heat the vinegar in a small stainless steel or enamel saucepan. Remove from heat, beat in the mustard and the remaining olive oil. Season with rosemary, salt and pepper. Toss the arugula with all but two Tbsp dressing. Arrange the arugula on two plates. Slice the rack of lamb into individual chops and arrange them on top of the arugula. Drizzle with the remaining dressing and serve.
