California Dreamin'



Rolling hills and majestic vineyards in Santa Barbara. Its proximity to the Santa Ynez Mountains and the Pacific Ocean creates a unique microclimate often described as Mediterranean, which is ideal for grape-growing.

California winemaking traditions date back to the late 1700s, when Spanish missionaries from Mexico brought winemaking to California. With almost 250 years' experience, a balance of respect for tradition and openness to innovation and a kind grape-growing climate, California is a winemaking oasis. An extremely diverse region, California has nearly 100 grape varieties and viticultural areas and can be divided into five major wine regions:

The Northern California Coast, just north of San Francisco, includes Mendocino, Lake County, Sonoma, Napa and Carneros; The Central California Coast stretches from San Francisco to Santa Barbara; Sierra Nevada,

home of the infamous 1849 Gold Rush, is east of San Francisco; The Central Valley includes Lodi and the San Joaquin Valley; and Southern California extends from Los Angeles to San Diego.

Chardonnay and Cabernet Sauvignon are the champions, with Merlot and Zinfandel fast on their heels. Pinot Noir, Syrah, Petite Sirah and Sauvignon Blanc are all contenders, while Pinot Gris and Viognier are growing in popularity.

Stag's Leap's 1972 Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon and Chateau Montelena's 1973 Alexander Valley (Napa) Chardonnay shocked the wine

world when they won the historic Judgment of Paris blind wine tasting, putting California Cab and Chard on the map. This victory was fictionalized in the 2008 film *Bottle Shock*.

Zinfandel, first planted in 1850, has undergone extensive DNA testing, proving that Zin, Italian Primitivo and Croatian Crljenak are genetically the same grape. They don't yield identical wines, however, owing to clonal differences, varying climates and winemaking techniques. While they have the same DNA structure, they produce markedly different wines.

Pinot Noir is more suited to a cool climate and does exceptionally well in California's coastal regions, particularly Carneros, the Russian River Valley and Santa Barbara. Syrah, a French Rhone varietal, tends to be bold and complex, with ripe fruit and notes of earth, smoke and pepper. *Rhone Ranger* refers to wines made from American-grown Rhone wine varieties such as Syrah or Grenache. In much the same way, Meritage Wines are made from Bordeaux varieties. Reds include Cabernet Sauvignon,

Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot, Carmenere and Malbec. White Meritages include Sauvignon Blanc and Semillon.

California Chardonnay, the state's most widely planted grape, is typically oaky and buttery, announcing its fruit-forward presence without a trace of shyness. Sauvignon Blanc tends toward fruity and grassy, with far less emphatic grapefruit flavors than New Zealand Sauv Blancs.

And don't forget about Sparklers. Made mostly from Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, California Sparklers employ the same techniques used in the Champagne region, known as *Methodo Champenoise*, yielding dry, crisp wines with notes of brioche, nuts and luscious fruit.

Whether you are a California wine lover or you haven't yet ventured into that territory of gold in a glass, you're bound to find wines of integrity and strong character, wines that are big in flavor, body and personality. So rouse yourself from California dreamin' and pop that cork. ♦

Sheila's Fig, Caramelized Onion & Gorgonzola Pizza

Pizza dough for one large pie
6 Tbsp olive oil, divided
2 large onions, sliced into strips
sprinkling of sea salt
5 fresh figs, quartered
8 oz Gorgonzola cheese
Freshly ground black pepper



Place pizza stone in oven and preheat to 500°. While the oven preheats, cook onions on low heat in 4 tablespoons olive oil and a shower of sea salt for at least 30 minutes, until fully caramelized. Stretch out dough and cover with onions, figs, remaining 2 Tbsp oil and black pepper. Place pizza on hot stone, turn oven down to 425° and cook for 10 minutes. Crumble gorgonzola over pizza and cook for 5 minutes, until crisp, golden and blistered around edges.

Limonage a Trois Martini

2 oz chilled Absolut Citron Vodka
½ to ¾ oz Limoncello
Strip of lemon zest
Lemon juice and sugar for rim of glass



Shake Vodka and Limoncello vigorously. Pour into lemon- and sugar-rimmed, chilled martini glass. Garnish with lemon strip, and sip.

Cucumber Dill-Icious

2 parts Crop Organic Cucumber Vodka
1 part fresh lime juice
½ part agave nectar
Muddled cucumber and dill



Muddle cucumber, dill and agave. Add Vodka and lime juice. Shake over ice and strain into a martini glass. Garnish with cucumber slice.
